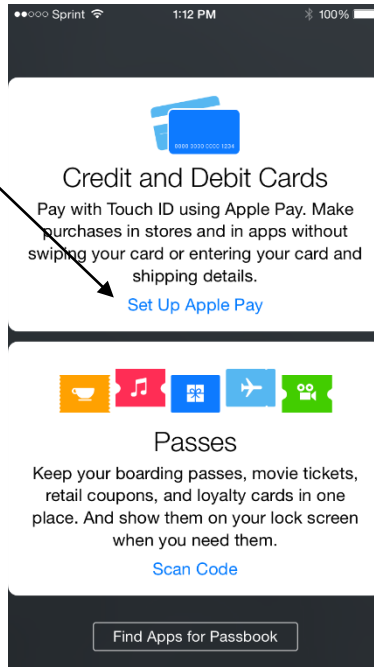


# Setting Up Apple Pay

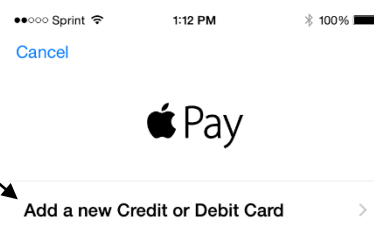
- 1) Open Passbook on your device.



- 2) Select "Set Up Apple Pay".




- 3) Select "Add a new Credit or Debit Card".



Apple Pay Terms of Use

These Terms of Use govern your use of Commonwealth Credit Union (CCU) credit cards and debit cards (Cards) in the Apple Pay application.

1. Apple Pay Service.

Apple Pay is a service provided by Apple, Inc. for the purpose of using a compatible wireless phone, tablet, or other compatible device (Device) to purchase goods and services from merchants who accept Apple Pay as a form of payment. Apple Pay enables you to create and store virtual representations of your eligible CCU Cards on your Device. Apple Pay uses your Device to authorize your transaction at the merchant's point of sale terminal or reader without your plastic CCU Card. Apple Pay routes the transaction charge to the Card you have designated and authorizes payment to the merchant.

Apple Pay may not be accepted at all places where your CCU Card is accepted. Transactions on your CCU Card initiated through Apple Pay are governed by the applicable CCU Card Agreement. Apple's Terms & Conditions for the Apple Pay service describe your rights and obligations regarding the Apple Pay service.

2. Eligibility & Enrollment.

Only CCU Cards that we indicate are eligible can be added to the Apple Pay service. If your CCU Card or underlying account is not in compliance with the applicable CCU Card Agreement, that CCU Card will not be eligible to enroll in the Apple Pay service. You can add an eligible CCU Card to the Apple Pay service by registering the Card through Apple Pay by following the Apple Pay authentication and enrollment requirements.

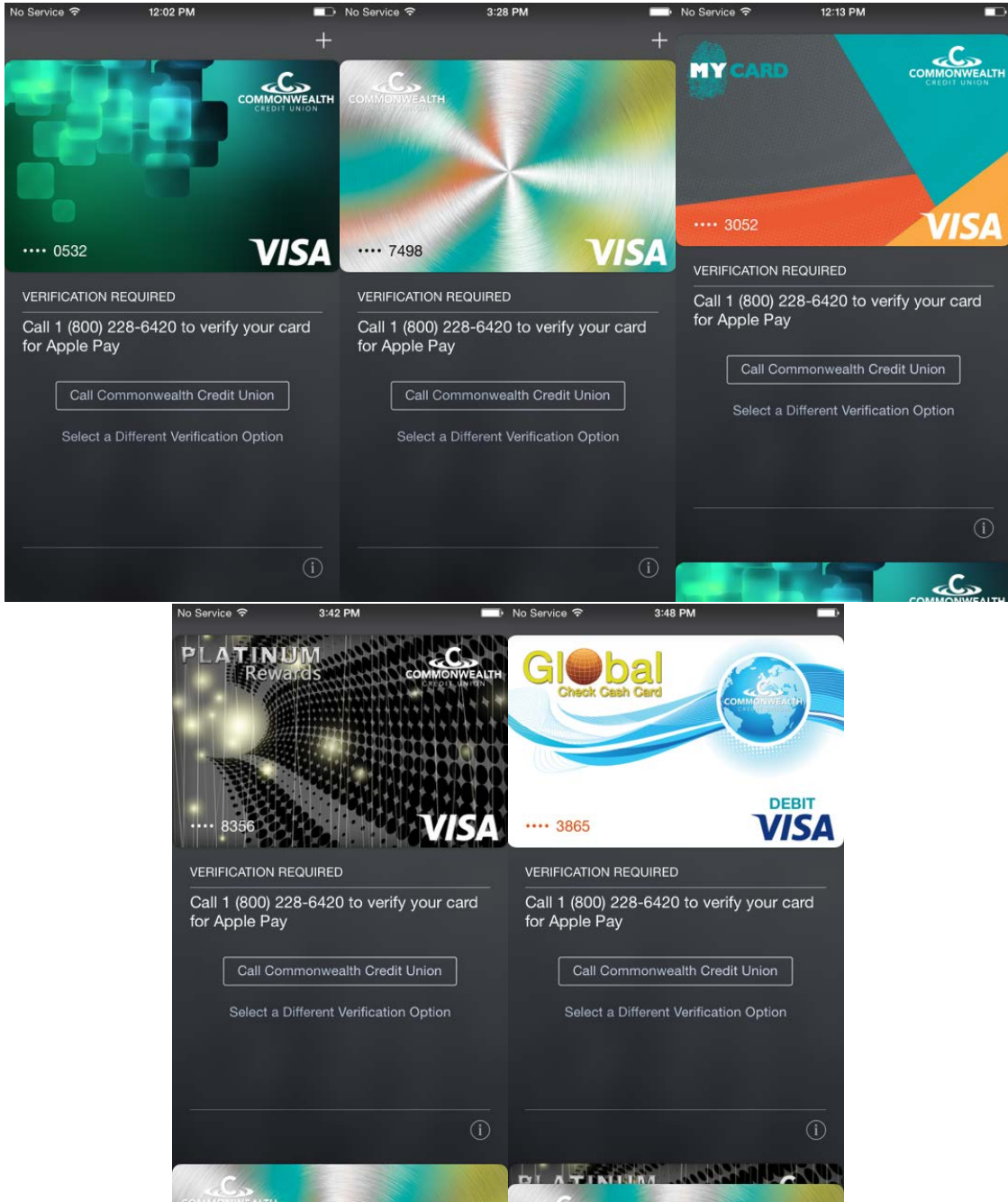

You can hit the info button to view the back of the card. On the back of the card there will be many options for the member. (Able to open CCU app, turn on/off notifications, transaction history, last 4 digits of card, last 4 digits of tokenized card number, link to privacy policy, link to terms and conditions, can remove card from Apple Pay, and an option to contact us)
